

Chan Wai Chun was born on 1st March 1999 and grew up in Hong Kong. He started to learn music at 7 years old with Euphonium. He passed Grade 5 with distinction at 10 years old. Later, he started learning trombone and won the music festival as second runner up at 11 years old. He started his major instrument, which is Tuba, at 12 years old till now.

He is currently studying with Professor Visser Anne Jelle. He received the education with Hong-yip Cheng, Paul Luxenberg, the principal tuba of Hong Kong Philharmonic and Tak Chun Lai, the former principal tuba of Auckland Symphony Orchestra

With the school music festival of solo tuba, he wins the competition continuously from 2014 to 2018. He also won the brass concerto in 2018. In 2016, he also won the Slider Asia Tuba solo. With the instrument qualification, he passed the Trinity LTCL examination with distinction in 2021.

He received the scholarship from Hong Kong Academy for Performing Arts between 2016 and 2018 with the junior program. In 2017, he received a chance to join the program “Share with the Stage” with HKphil. Study and play with professionals.

He started his bachelor studies in Hong Kong Academy for Performing Arts in 2018. He received a call from Suzhou Symphony Orchestra in 2019 as guest principal tuba. He also joined the Tuba Mania in Hong Kong which leads him learn more tuba technique from other tuba player and professionals.

He started his first master in Zürcher Hochschule der Künste with Master Performance in 2023. He is currently studying the second master, specialized soloist in same campus. He won the youth orchestra audition in 2024 with Asian Youth Orchestra with visiting different Asia places and having concerts to gain more experience.
